The average home can generate as much as 100 pounds of household hazardous waste (HHW) per year.

If not disposed of properly HHW can contaminate the water.

NEVER put household hazardous waste:

- Down the drain
- In the toilet
- On the ground
- In a storm drain
- In a septic tank
- In the trash
